There were 4 Ceremonies in which I participated;

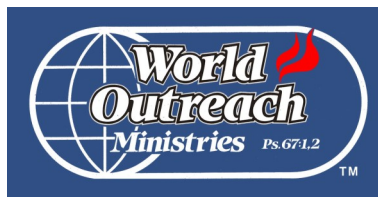
American Heroes Flag, VFW & Legion Virtual Ceremony, Daughters of the American Revolution, and the Disabled American Veterans.
